The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Regional Integration of Ghana is collating information on Ghanaians and Legal Permanent Residents who are stranded abroad as a result of the closure of international borders in containment of the Covid-19 Pandemic.

To this end, eligible nationals **who are prepared to pay for their cost of travel to Ghana** must submit their details specified below to the Ghana High Commission not later than close of day on Wednesday, 13th May 2020:
