distribution, and disposal. The switch from tobacco farming to nutritious crop cultivation will not only make food available in abundance for people across the nation but also improve the livelihood of farmers in the world at large.

World No Tobacco Day 2023 serves as an opportunity to mobilize governments and policymakers to support the implementation of tobacco control laws and policies across the country. This campaign also calls on civil society, academia, the media and all individuals to support the government of Ghana in developing suitable strategies with the ultimate aim of creating a tobacco-free society.
