

Self test Ghana

What is Self Test?

Self Test is an innovative health service that makes HIV self test kits available and accessible to users. Self test is part of the Global Fund's Differentiated Service Delivery Strategic Initiatives (DSD SI).

Who are we?

Self test is designed and delivered by SH:24, a UK based online sexual and reproductive health service, as an international technical assistance to the Government of Ghana to design and develop human-centred virtual interventions for local HIV service delivery organisations.

What do we do?

Self Test Ghana provides service-users with the opportunity to order a free HIV self test kit online and have it delivered to them for free at a location of their choice within Accra and Tema by courier. Service-users are encouraged to interact with a virtual support team of sexual health professionals to report their test results and receive support to access HIV prevention and treatment services.

Who is involved?

Self Test is a partnership with the Ghana Health Service (GHS), the National AIDS/STI Control Programme (NACP) and the Ghana-West African Program to Combat AIDS and STI (WAPCAS).

Why Self Test?

This is to improve testing and treatment coverage of key populations, and other risk groups, and address challenges to traditional HIV service delivery models.
